
Healthcare



We prepare doctors and dentists for practice
We offer two doctoral study programmes: general
medicine and dentistry. The programmes take 6 years to
complete and can only be studied in-person and full-time.
Our excellent teachers maintain contacts with renowned
partners from the most eminent European and American
universities. We also offer postgraduate doctoral studies
both in-house and externally, as well as specialization

- We use innovative methods of education
 We are intimately familiar with the specific nature of medical teaching. That is why we employ cutting-edge and innovative approaches that prepare our students to apply the acquired knowledge practically. We use modern methods to build their communication and practical skills. We also use sophisticated patient simulators in our teaching and have our own 3D bioprinter. We were the first in Slovakia to use virtual reality for anatomy teaching.

 Our faculty is popular among students from abroad, who currently comprise almost a third of our students. This year, you will have colleagues from Germany, Japan, Poland, Ukraine, the United Kingdom, Greece, and other countries. Not only is this an opportunity to study in a multilingual environment, but you can also learn about the culture and traditions of different countries and start many lifelong friendships.

FACULTY OF LAW



✓ Beyond the boundaries of Slovak law

At our faculty, you can study law in English at the bachelor's degree level, and at the master's degree level, you can study both EU law and international law in English.

✓ Work on practical cases

We combine over a century of tradition in legal education with innovative approaches. You will solve simulated cases (moot courts) and study clinical subjects regularly. We connect study and practice through the student-run legal advice project implemented in cooperation with the Slovak Bar Association.

✓ A career in diplomacy? No problem!

You can study at the Academy of Diplomacy to obtain a BLC (British Law Centre diploma), study the essentials of Austrian private law, or receive an E.MA (European master's in human rights and democratization) - our faculty offers all of these on your path to the international job market.

✓ Internships during study

We can arrange internships at dozens of institutions (e.g., The Slovak office of the Prosecutor General, the Slovak Parliament, the Office of the Slovak President, nearly any ministry, and the Slovak Supreme Court), where students can obtain experience working as lawyers, increasing their chances on the labour market.

Master Languages, Explore Central Europe
The Central European Studies programme offers
a unique opportunity to master two Central European
languages while gaining deep cultural insight into the
region. Combining language studies with history, culture,
and social issues, it equips you for international careers.
You will develop a strong understanding of intercultural
communication, cultural differences, and the socio-political landscape of Central Europe, enabling you to navigate
and overcome language and cultural barriers.

FACULTY OF NATURAL SCIENCES



✓ The whole world is learning from us

Our researchers developed a process that can significantly shorten the production of a flu medicine; they discovered a new protein, Dbl2, which can repair damaged genetic information (DNA); they participated in mapping the three-dimensional structure of the PatA enzyme, which has led to a significant advance in the fight against tuberculosis. And that's just a fraction of our ongoing research in biology, environmental science, geography, geology, and chemistry.

✓ Nature is our life

Our fulfilment and intrigue are in finding solutions to the climate crisis and protecting nature and health. With us, you can participate in projects to improve public health, safeguard habitats and animal and plant species, restore critical natural areas, or remediate the geological environment and environmental burdens.

✓ At our faculty, you won't be buried in books

The Himalayas, Iceland, Mexico, Tanzania, and Honduras that's just a small sample of what awaits you. Suppose you decide to study natural sciences in Slovak or English. In that case, you can use top-notch laboratories and participate in field research and professional excursions in attractive locations.

The pharmacy programme is a 5-year full-time master's study programme taught in English. Our pharmacy degree is recognised throughout the EU in the regulated health-care profession of pharmacy. The curriculum is fully compatible with European universities.

For 20 years, pharmacy students have been gaining hands-on experience through a six-month internship in line with EU standards. Pharmacy graduates enter the profession well-prepared and competent. Beyond traditional pharmacies, students can also explore internships with future employers in various pharmacy-related fields.

Simulation-based teaching and hands-on clinical practice ensure you'll develop the practical skills needed to succeed in healthcare. The faculty simulation center, featuring audio-visual technologies that enable 3D transmission and recording of surgeries all give the study a more intense and realistic dimension, enhancing the learning experience and sparking a more profound curiosity and drive to learn more. Education at our faculty will be further enhanced once the biobank is finished and a recently approved new university hospital in Martin is completed.


✓ The Martin club of medics

We offer state-of-the-art research facilities, our own nuclear and accelerator technology center, a center for complex systems, an astronomical and geophysical observatory, and a laboratory for future computer technologies.

Study data science, bioinformatics, economic and financial mathematics, renewable resources, energy, environmental physics, teaching, and other study programmes. We offer a wide array of possibilities.
