French-speaking Belgium has to offer different higher education institutions : 6 universities, 19 university colleges and 16 arts schools.

The language used for teaching and the everyday environment is therefore mainly French. ### The globalisation of French-speaking Belgium higher education in figures

- Every year, almost 20% of all international students and 40% of foreign PhD students choose Belgium for their studies.
- More than 55% of all Belgian scientific publications are co-published with foreign researchers.
- Almost 20% of all academic or scientific staff are of foreign origin.
- Thousands of joint programmes have been developed, including "Erasmus Mundus" Master degrees and PhDs.
- Numerous courses are held in English, Dutch, Spanish and German.

### How much does a study stay cost in the Wallonia-Brussels Federation?

In French-speaking Belgium, access to higher education is a priority. This is why the Wallonia-Brussels Federation government chooses to subsidise much of the cost of studying. This means that registration fees are fairly low yet the quality of study is excellent. Although there are general guidelines for registration fees, each higher education institution is free to set its own prices. International students pay between €835 and €4,175 in registration fees, depending on the chosen institution and programme and their status.
