Non-EU students:

Year 1: 10 500 € - Year 2 and 3: 11 000 €

ADMISSION PROCESS

- 1- Register online: *apply.yschools.fr*
- 2- Upload application documents
- 3- Sit entrance tests
- 4- Receive admission results
- 5- Confirm your admission

Registration fees (50 €, secure online payment).

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

M1 level: after 3 years of successful higher education (180 ECTS)

M2 level: students holding a Master 1 certificate (completion of 240 ECTS)

Before your arrival in Troyes:

- Find accommodation
- Understand how to process your visa application if you need one.
- Open a French bank account (required to receive housing financial support from CAF)
- Subscribe to a mobile phone plan
- Subscribe to housing insurance (mandatory in France)

Once you set foot in Troyes:

- Enrol in CAF (housing allowance from the state)
- · Visa validation (only for non-EU students)
- Public transportation card subscription
- Subscribe to electricity for your accommodation
- Health insurance subscription for non-EU students
